Dear Co-worker:

Just a short note to let you know that GA has arrived home safely, very tired, but otherwise in apparently good condition. He has been relaxing luxuriously in trunks and sandals during our intensely hot days, but I am afraid it will take quite a long time before he entirely unwinds. He is requesting here that visitors not drive up during July and August. One cannot rest completely when having to remain constantly alert for callers or being interrupted in what he may be doing by visitors who want to "just say hello" but stay for hours.

GA intended dictating this letter, including a report of his trip, but just didn't feel up to it. So he has asked me to thank each of you for the tireless effort you spent in his behalf, for the accomplishments made through your efforts and for your kindnesses and considerations of him during his visit with you. He promises a report on his trip, with new information he has gained, as quickly as he feels more rested and able to get his thoughts together better.

He is also eager to get memories of his experiences on paper in preparation for the ms. of his next book which he hopes to complete before the end of this year.

To those whose lecture arrangements he was forced to cancel because of doctor's orders, due to an over-tired condition and a deep cold affecting his lungs, GA sends his regrets for his inability to fulfill your schedules. He hopes there will be another time when he can visit you. That will require a much shorter schedule than his recent tour, with a minimum of public lectures... larger ones rather than many small ones. But all that must be worked out in the future depending on many factors. To those of you who were able to visit with him in Basel he is very grateful for the opportunity of meeting you personally and hopes that the material he made available to you will serve you and your countrymen well.

Again, let us both thank you sincerely for your full cooperation and support in every way and for your kind and thoughtful consideration of GA. I am sure all of us have learned many lessons through our experiences... lessons that will serve us well in many ways as we continue our association with one another and with our fellowmen everywhere.
