Received your most welcome letter of Aug 31st. I hope you do succeed with your undertaking as I will be most happy to visit all of you and give you information that sometimes cannot be written in a letter. I do not know why you have chosen August but that is C. K. with me.

Now whether or not I can reise some money for the part of the fare or how much, I cannot say at this time, but I will try

to help the cause along if possible.

Yes I can take passage on the ship, it would be cheaper I presume but a ship would involve more time to travel so it would have to be scheduled and plenty of time allowed for the time it would take to get to your lovely country. No I have no plans besides the lecture. Yes I would bring my film along, it has now been converted to 8 m.m. it is easier to handle; so you would have to furnish a 8 mm projector.

Now knowing too much about your economic conditions in your country I do not know what you should charge as a fee to the lecture. Here in U. S.A. some charge \$1. per person, some\$1.80

per person.

I can stay in your country for ten days or even more say fiftee unless things should work up along the line as one can never tell as the route by plane would take me near Australia, one

way or the other and also near New Zealand.

since you have mentioned in the co-workers letter to Henk and Moy Russell, there could be a chance that they may want to invite me to their countries since I would be making that route if it is by plane; and if they did, they could make a small contribution towards the fare, I could come to your country first and on my way back stop in their country. I may be hearing from them since you informed them so; or if not I willwrite to them about the idea.

At the moment it looks as though I might be going to Dermark for next year's congress as I did this year, at least Hans mentioned it in his last letter, the possibility exists, that again would be probably the same months, which was this year. I suppose they hold this congress in the same month each year. I have not looked at the map to know just what the distances are between Dermark or London and Japan, are they diorter or longer than they are from U. S. A. but we have plenty of time yet to see how all of this could work out that it wouldn't be too hard on any one group be it from Dermark to your country or be it from Australia and New Zealand could come into your country. Of course on these conditions it would have to be by plane to make up the time but on returning back to U. S. A. it couldbe by ship as that would give me arest before getting home and I would not be in a hurry.

So now this is nothing but a speculation, just how things could work out and we will keep that in mind and see what could be done in getting some other groups to help along as to make

it easier on you if possible.
